MATTHEW 28:18-20 *Then Jesus came near and said to them, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."*



ROMANS 15:23 *"But now having no more place in these parts..."*

Do we see **#NoPlaceLeft** anywhere in the New Testament (get the gospel out to every resident in their area)? Let's check out the Bible and see...

- **JERUSALEM:** "And there arose on that day a great persecution against the church in Jerusalem, and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles. 4 Now those who were scattered went about preaching the word. [11:19] Now those who were scattered because of the persecution that arose over Stephen traveled as far as Phoenicia and Cyprus and Antioch, speaking the word" -Acts 8:1, 4; 11:19

- **ANTIOCH:** "While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them. 3Then after fasting and praying they laid their hands on them and sent them off. [15:23] (letter from Jerusalem council) "to the brothers who are of the Gentiles in Antioch and Syria and Cilicia" -Acts 13:2-3; 15:23

- **PISIDIAN ANTIOCH:** "And the word of the Lord was spreading throughout the whole region" -Acts 13:49 **#NoPlaceLeftPisidia**
- **THESSALONICA:** "For not only has the word of the Lord sounded forth from you in Macedonia and Achaia" -1 Thessalonians 1:8 "from Jerusalem and all the way around to Illyricum I have fulfilled the ministry of the gospel of Christ" -Romans 15:19 **#NoPlaceLeftMacedoniaAchaiaIllyricum**
- **EPHESUS:** "This continued for two years, so that ALL the residents of Asia (8-15million) heard the word of the Lord, both Jews and Greeks" Acts 19:10
#NoPlaceLeftAsia

SO PAUL WAS ABLE TO SAY...

*"But now, since I have **#NoPlaceLeft** to work in these regions" -Romans 15:23*



Other churches in these cities got the gospel out to their surrounding regions! Churches took on the great commission task & got to #NoPlaceLeft! Will you? Will your family?

REMEMBER, JESUS SAID...

"All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." -Matthew 28:18-20

AND

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." -Acts 1:8

AND

"And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come."

-Matthew 24:14

#NoPlaceLeft was His plan accomplished by His power all along!

PAUL'S PATTERN

First, we see that Paul followed the model or example of Jesus Christ.

Let's look at some verses.

^{NAU} **1 CORINTHIANS 11:1**

Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ.

We see that Paul imitated Jesus in the way (Methodology) he did things.

Second, we see that Paul had a pattern, which he learned from Christ and that he taught to others.

Let's look at some verses.

^{NIV} **PHILIPPIANS 3:17**

Join with others in following my example, brothers, and take note of those who live according to the pattern we gave you.

^{NIV} **1 CORINTHIANS 4:17**

For this reason I am sending to you Timothy, my son whom I love, who is faithful in the Lord. He will remind you of my way of life in Christ Jesus, which agrees with what I teach everywhere in every church.

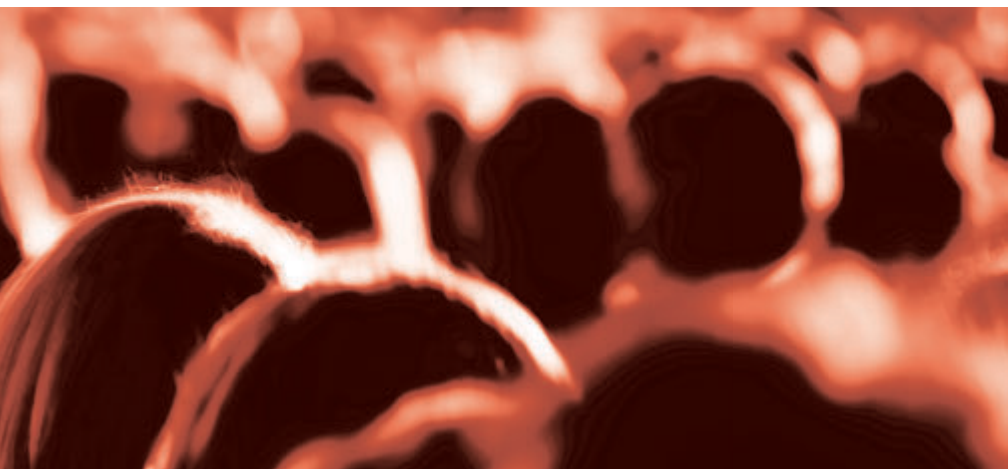
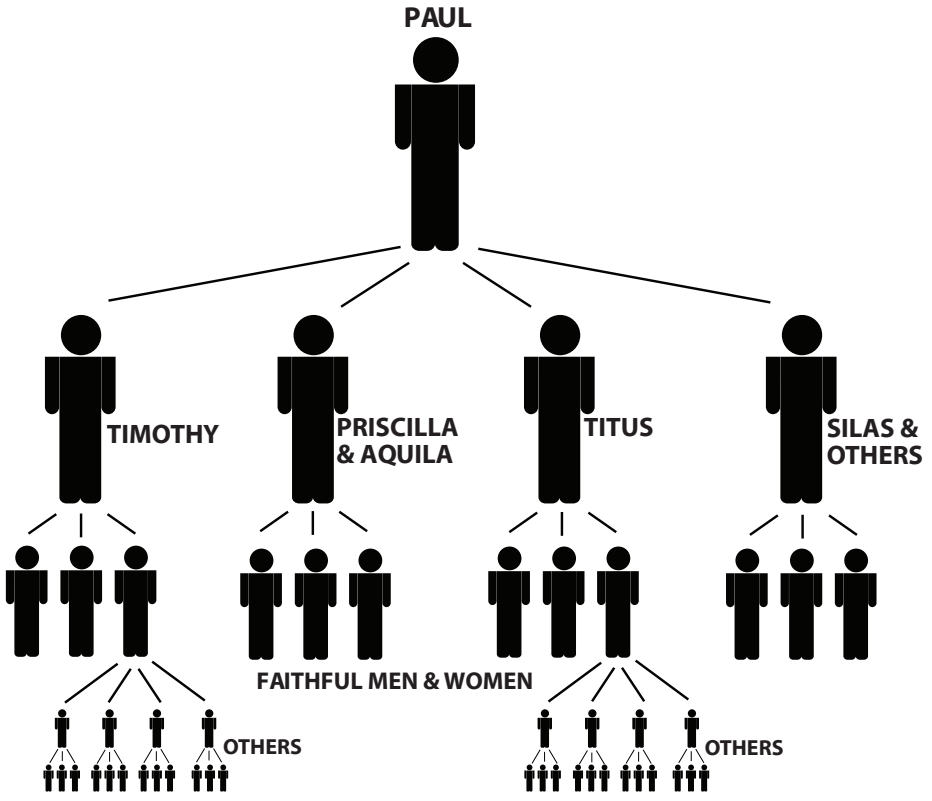
^{NIV} **2 TIMOTHY 2:2**

And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others.

SWAP BEING FILLED WITH YOURSELF AND INSTEAD BE FILLED WITH THE **HOLY SPIRIT**

EPHESIANS 5:18

And don't get drunk with wine, which leads to reckless actions, but be filled by the Spirit:

In the original Greek, "be filled" means "keep on being filled constantly and continually."

The moment you received Christ, the Holy Spirit not only came to indwell you, but He imparted to you spiritual life, causing you to be born anew as a child of God. The Holy Spirit also baptized you into the body of Christ. In I Corinthians 12:13, Paul explains, "We were all baptized by one Spirit into one body." There is but one indwelling of the Holy Spirit, one rebirth of the Holy Spirit, and one baptism of the Holy Spirit -- all of which occur when you receive Christ. Being filled with the Holy Spirit, however, is not a once-for-all experience. There are many fillings, as is made clear in Ephesians 5:1



- **S: Surrender control** - dump out yourself(you must dump out your cup to fill it with another substance) - Abide in His word and He abides in us (Meditate on John 15:1-17) - whatever He says we respond YES! (Blank Sheet - sign the paper) Death to SELF
- **W: Wait for God** - God has to act - Wait in Prayer (10 day prayer meeting, 40 days on mountain, 40 days in desert) Frequent forays to stay filled By faith receive Him - Come and fill me!

SPIRITUAL BREATHING

EXHALE:

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness

INHALE:

1 John 5:14-15 Now this is the confidence we have before Him: Whenever we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears whatever we ask, we know that we have what we have asked Him for. (From Ephesians 5:8 we know His will is for us to be "filled with the Holy Spirit")

P.

- **A: Avoid even a hint of sin** - Do Not Grieve the Holy Spirit - Put On/ Put Off (Ephesians 4:17-32 & 5:1-21/ Colossians 3:1-17)
- **P: Prompting Praise & Proclamation** - sing a song from your heart - Talk to people - Share your story and Jesus Story - Say yes to every prompting - this is the Dance - Jesus is calling us to Dance with Him. Twice in New Testament spirit is called spirit of Jesus. You will get just as weird as Jesus. You will Manifest fruit of spirit & joy. Ephesians 5:19

Now that you signed contract. Do this! Don't say no! If you say NO you have to start over. Our goal is how long can we say yes to every prompting Extended periods of time in spirit. You experience fruit. But you also experience Jesus.



FOUR FIELDS STRATEGY

MARK 4:26-29

3 TRAINING PRINCIPLES

1. **Simple**- Not complex rocket science
2. **Reproducible**- Do it anywhere and produce fruit
3. **Transferable** Anyone can learn it and teach it

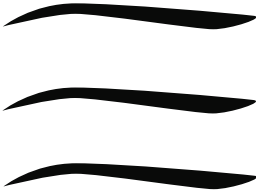
TRAINING METHOD

1. **Model**- Provide information and a demonstration
2. **Assist**- Help student with sticking points
3. **Watch**- Observe and provide godly feedback
4. **Leave**- Leave student with assignment and follow up
